



THE BLACK CHOOK SHIRAZ 2009

With 2009 being the seventh vintage of this cleverly crafted Shiraz with just a touch of Viognier, The Black Chook has gained fans from all across the world including here, in Australia.

The 2009 vintage again provided excellent fruit due to the superb weather at the start of the growing season. The seamless integration of Shiraz co-fermented with Viognier, generates a seductive nose of apricots, spice and ripe berries. The palate is smooth and full of rich flavour, perfect for a long lingering finish of delightfully soft Shiraz fruit, but not without the punch.

The Black Chook Shiraz is sourced from the premium grape growing regions of McLaren Vale and Langhorne Creek in South Australia.

McLaren Vale has an unrivalled reputation in Australia and indeed the world, for growing Shiraz which is full-flavoured, ripe and balanced. With excellent fruit and length, McLaren Vale Shiraz also has a terrific ability to age. Situated approximately 40km to the south of Adelaide, the capital of South Australia,

McLaren Vale has a Mediterranean-type climate. With winter dominant rainfall, warm, dry summers that are tempered by the proximity to the Gulf St. Vincent and low humidity, McLaren Vale has one of the most consistent climates in which to grow premium wine grapes.

Located on the floodplains of the Angas and Bremer Rivers about 70km south of Adelaide, Langhorne Creek is one of the older wine growing regions in Australia with the first vines planted in the 1850's. Traditionally, Langhorne Creek is a red growing area, and characteristically produces Shiraz that is spicy, flavoursome and elegant. Recent years have seen white varieties becoming more established in the region. The Viognier in The Black Chook is sourced from both Langhorne Creek and McLaren Vale.

Co-fermenting small amounts of Viognier skins with Shiraz intensifies the deep rich colour and velvety mouthfeel of the wine.
